

Die Kunst des Tagebuchs: Europäische Literatur in Briefen und Tagebüchern The Art of the Diary: European Diaristic Writing

Workshop description:

"I won't give up the diary again. I must hold on here, it is the only place I can," Kafka noted in his diary on December 16, 1910. What motivates writers to keep diaries? In which ways do they make use of this medium and at what point are diaries (or journals) considered 'literary'? On the other hand, how do authors employ the structure and techniques of the diary to create fictional narratives? And what functions does the diary have, alongside the letter, in novels such as André Gide's *Les Faux-Monnayeurs*? These and similar questions will guide the reading of significant English, French, and German language diaries, diary novels and other 20th century writings that creatively incorporate the diaristic. Participants will explore the works of Franz Kafka, André Gide, Max Frisch and Doris Lessing, among others, in terms of their (literary) historical, cultural, poetological and aesthetic dimensions from a comparative perspective. They will be familiarized with 'classical' and recent theoretical approaches to the diary and the diary novel, discuss terminological and genre-specific aspects (e.g., the relationship of the diary to autobiography, memoirs, and the letter) and apply the established methods of narratological analysis to selected texts.
